**NOISE LEVEL** The noise level of any machine must not exceed 89 DbA. A driver who fails to comply with this regulation **WILL BE** excluded. Noise meter operator to attend all meetings.

**NOTE TO ALL COMPETITORS** Cut out lanyards NOT TO be made of coiled stretch leads. When warming up a machine the operator must wear a cut out lanyard. If for any reason you are unable to ride during the day, please let the Comps secretary know.
